3D Sounds Phonics Cards

Kindergarten/Foundation: Exploring Phonemic Awareness



Curriculum Links:

- + **AC9EFLY12:** Recognise and generate rhyming words, alliteration patterns, syllables and sounds (phonemes) in spoken words.

Lesson Objectives:

- + Develop phonemic awareness by identifying and manipulating sounds in words.
- + Enhance understanding of letter-sound relationships through interactive activities.

Lesson Activities:

- + **Sound Matching:** Use the 3D Sounds Phonics Cards to introduce various phonemes. Students match objects with the corresponding initial sounds.
- + **Rhyming Pairs:** Select cards and have students identify words that rhyme with the depicted object, reinforcing rhyming skills.

- + **Alliteration Fun:** Create sentences using words that start with the same sound as the object on a chosen card, promoting alliteration awareness.

Assessment:

- + Observe students' ability to correctly match sounds and generate rhyming words.
- + Conduct oral assessments focusing on phoneme identification and manipulation.

Differentiation:

- + **Support:** Focus on initial sounds before introducing more complex phonemic tasks.
- + **Extension:** Encourage students to create their own sentences or stories using multiple alliterative words.
