Year 3: Enhancing Spelling and Word Recognition



Curriculum Links:

+ AC9E3LY09: Use knowledge of letter-sound relationships, common and uncommon letter patterns and spelling generalisations to spell words accurately.

Lesson Objectives:

- + Strengthen understanding of spelling patterns through hands-on word construction.
- + Identify and apply common and less common letter combinations in spelling.

Lesson Activities:

- Pattern Practice: Students use the magnetic letters to build words featuring common and tricky patterns (e.g., "igh", "tion", "ough").
 Discuss how different patterns affect pronunciation and meaning.
- + Word Sorts: Provide categories such as vowel teams, prefixes/suffixes or digraphs. Students sort magnetic letters into groups and build example words under each category.

+ **Spelling Challenge**: In pairs or small groups, students take turns giving each other spelling words from their word list and building them on a magnetic board. Introduce time or point-based challenges to keep it engaging.

Assessment:

- + Observation during activities to assess correct spelling and use of patterns.
- + A follow-up written task using a selection of the words built with magnetic letters.

Differentiation:

- + **Support**: Provide visual prompts or anchor charts with spelling rules and examples. Focus on high-frequency or decodable words.
- + Extension: Ask students to build multisyllabic or compound words and use them in original sentences or short paragraphs.
