Phonics Skill-Building Pocket Chart

Year 2: Advancing Phonics Skills

Curriculum Links:

- + **AC9E2LY10:** Use phonics and word knowledge to fluently read and write words.

Lesson Objectives:

- + Strengthen decoding and encoding skills through interactive phonics activities.
- + Enhance vocabulary and spelling proficiency.

Lesson Activities:

- + **Sorting Sounds:** Using the Pocket Chart, students categorise words based on common phonetic patterns or sounds.
