Lesson Plan

Reading Rods Alphabet & Phonemic Awareness Set

Year 1: Building Alphabet Knowledge

Curriculum Links:

+ AC9E1LY11: Use knowledge of letters and sounds to spell words.

Lesson Objectives:

- + Recognise and sequence letters of the alphabet.
- + Develop phonemic awareness by constructing simple words.

Lesson Activities:

- + Alphabet Sequencing: Students use Reading Rods to arrange letters in alphabetical order, reinforcing letter recognition.
- + Word Building: Provide a set of Reading Rods for students to construct CVC (consonant-vowelconsonant) words, enhancing decoding skills.
- + Phoneme Substitution: Challenge students to change one letter in a word to create a new word, promoting understanding of sound-letter relationships.

Assessment:

- + Evaluate students' ability to correctly sequence the alphabet and form words.
- + Conduct spelling checks on words created during activities.

Differentiation:

- + **Support**: Focus on a smaller set of letters or simple words initially.
- + Extension: Encourage students to create longer words or explore word families.
